Today, the vegetation canvasses the eastern slope of the Landfill, and has even begun sprouting small spring flowers. We will continue routine maintenance throughout the spring and summer, and once mature, the vegetation will help prevent erosion and soil thinning, and act as a natural bio-filter.
