

Sunshine Canyon Landfill Completes Winterization Preparations

SYLMAR, Calif. Oct. 12, 2018) – As we have previously reported, the Sunshine Canyon Landfill team has been preparing the site for winter. With the rainy season approaching, we want to be sure we can effectively manage storm water as we have done in the past, and prevent any damage to landfill infrastructure. After months of activity, this week our team completed these preparations. Since July, our team has:

- Cleaned all site basins of debris and sediment to promote proper storm water flow;
- Completed construction of a 6,000-linear-feet silt fence to control sediment migration;
- Laid 14 acres of coconut matting on landfill slopes to protect landfill cover soils; and
- Installed 30,000 linear feet of fiber rolls and geotextile as erosion controls.

Although we prefer blue skies and sunshine, because of the hundreds of hours our team committed to winterizing the Landfill, we will be ready when the rain comes.
