

Sunshine Canyon Landfill Continuing Winter Preparations

SYLMAR, Calif. (Sept. 28, 2018) – In July, the Sunshine Canyon Landfill team shared actions we were taking to prepare the facility for winter to effectively manage storm water and prevent potential damage to our roads, landfill slopes and landfill gas collection and control system. At the time, we were clearing silt and debris from storm water channels, repairing minor erosion on landfill slopes, planting vegetation, and installing infrastructure to properly channel storm water.

With fall officially here, we are continuing these efforts. Some of the more recent actions we have taken include:

- Installing geotextile, fiber rolls and 14 acres of coconut matting on landfill slopes to help control erosion and protect landfill cover soils;
- Constructing a silt fence on a portion of the western slope to control sediment; and
- Cleaning out additional basins, channels and pipes to promote proper storm water flow.

We still anticipate completing winterization efforts by October 1 so that we are prepared when the rain begins.
