



Landfill Gas-to-Energy Plant Completes Maintenance Event

SYLMAR, Calif. Nov. 2, 2018 – The Sunshine Canyon Landfill is the site of a landfill gas-to-energy (LFTGE) plant. Fueled by landfill gas generated and collected from both the City and County portions of the Landfill, the 20-megawatt facility is capable of generating enough renewable electricity to power nearly 25,000 homes.

Because of its advanced technology, the plant requires consistent monitoring and semi-annual maintenance events by its third-party operator, Sunshine Gas Producers. The plant recently conducted one of these maintenance events, which included replacing all five turbine engines and additional support equipment. This new equipment allows the plant to further enhance on-site landfill gas collection and control, and continue providing renewable energy to our community.
