Sunshine Canyon Landfill's Continued Commitment

SYLMAR, Calif. (Dec. 14, 2018) – In early 2017, the Sunshine Canyon Landfill team announced a number of enhancements we were making to the Landfill's infrastructure and operations to control potential odor from the site. Since that time, we have made significant progress. Some of the key projects we have undertaken include:

- · Adding 256 wells to the landfill gas collection and control system;
- · Installing 317 dewatering pumps in landfill gas wells;
- · Covering 38.5 acres of the Landfill with intermediate spray-on cover;
- · Placing closure turf over 26.2 acres of the Landfill;
- Embedding 9 gabion cubes into new landfill cells;
- Installing 8,000 feet of horizontal landfill gas collectors;
- · Planting 58 acres of vegetative cover; and
- · Installing 12 acres of erosion control matting.

While we have made progress, we recognize we have more to do. We appreciate the patience and understanding our community has shown us during this time, and we will continue providing updates on future projects. We remain committed to managing the landfill in an environmentally responsible manner and serving as a good neighbor in our community.
