



Recent Power Surge Impacted Landfill Systems

SYLMAR, Calif. (Mar. 27, 2019) – Like many others in our community, on Monday, Sunshine Canyon Landfill experienced a massive power surge that damaged the systems that control our landfill gas collection and control infrastructure, including the on-site flare and landfill gas-to-energy plant. We are still investigating the cause of this unprecedented power surge, which originated from an off-site source on the Southern California Edison power grid. Our team worked around the clock to repair these systems and restore functionality. We have since stabilized our systems and are completing final repairs, as we work to return to normal landfill operations.
